Dear Families of Middle School Students,

With permission of a guardian, students in Grades 6 – 8 will be given the use of a locker and a lock in order to store belongings. Please read the guidelines below with your child and complete the tear off.

They will be given access to their lockers 2 times each day: 1) when they arrive in the morning and 2) during their lunch period.

Students will NOT be permitted to go to their lockers in-between periods. It is each student’s responsibility to plan accordingly and bring what they need for their classes after going to their locker in the morning.

Uniform locks will be provided by the school. No other locks will be permitted. The locks that will be provided are accessible by key by the school and will be collected at the end of the year. Students are not to share their combination with any other students.

NYC DOE Chancellor’s Regulation A-432 sets forth the standards and procedures for which lockers may be searched and will be adhered to by PS/IS 121.

NYC DOE Chancellor’s Regulation A-432 states:

“School lockers are the property of the Department of Education even when assigned to students. Lockers may be searched when there is reasonable suspicion to believe the lockers contain evidence that the student has violated or is violating the law and/or school rules and regulations...[or] in the event of an emergency which requires immediate intervention to protect the safety and security of the school community or any individual.”

Lockers are not to be decorated, written on, or altered in any way by students.
